Purpose of task:

There are two tasks which draw on the skills students need to be successful on this course. The first is a research task, which encourages you to think about repertoire from the vast and diverse performing arts world. The second is a performance task in the form of an audition piece, which allows you to demonstrate your personal sense of style and skill we would like you to provide a resume of previous works alongside this performance.

This work can be based on Dance, Drama **or** Music. It should be a solo piece and can be self-devised or a piece of existing/recognisable work. The audition piece should be **no longer than 3 minutes** and should showcase a range of skill and personality. Be prepared to answer questions with regards to your selection of this piece, the performance of which will take place **at lunchtime, in front of a panel in the first week of term**. It should be accompanied with an A4 printed resume of past performing arts experiences (including lessons, exams and extra-curricular)
