
What is the ASK programme?

The options shared in this directory offer information for everybody, whatever you want to do and whatever your starting point.

There are a variety of progression pathways you can take to build your career, different pathways suit different people because of your location, content or style, for some you can take different routes to achieve your goal. An example of this is you can take A Levels and progress to University to get a Degree, you can also get a degree in some occupations as an apprentice in an apprenticeship – working, being paid and learning. Apprenticeships

An apprenticeship is a real job, with a real employer, where the apprentice will work fulltime whilst learning new skills and knowledge towards the apprenticeship standard.

Apprenticeship benefits

Apprenticeships are an exciting paid option for anyone wanting to gain experience, upskill or change career because they offer the chance to earn a wage whilst they work and study.



A new initiative, part of the CITB Employer Network Pilot, has been set up and funded by CITB covering Dorset.

The concept being trialled offers a new way for CITB registered employers to get money for training, without any forms or claim process involved. We organise the training and remove the hassle of grant & funding paperwork from the employer.

This provides a fantastic opportunity for us to work more closely with you our ATOs and develop stronger relationships with you. It makes sense because training provision, addressing skills shortages and supporting employers are all areas that CITB and ATOs specialise in.
