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Dear Parent/Guardian

As you will be aware Year 12 students sat progress tests in each subject studied the week after half term. You are able to view the outcome of these tests through the parent portal. Year 12 Progress tests are assessed by class teachers who take into consideration each individual students prior attainment and report a progress grade that is relative to them. Progress is graded using 4 colours, each denote the following;

Purple	Student is making above expected progress
Green	Student is making expected progress
Amber	Student is not yet making expected progress
Red	Student is significantly below expected progress.

Students should discuss the outcome of these test with their class teacher to ensure they understand why they have achieved specific outcomes. Many students find this to be a useful marker either to validate the hard work they are putting in to their studies or as a reality check that they need to make positive changes in order to improve the progress they are making. If you wish to discuss the outcome of particular subject in greater detail please contact the relevant member of staff.

There will be further Year 12 progress tests in the New Year followed in March by a full review of the students' progress including predicted and potential grades.
