



Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) - Use of Mobile Devices in School

Technology offers us exciting opportunities for learning and you are encouraged to use computers and mobile devices to help you learn.

As in the outside world, to ensure that you enjoy the best possible experience using technology it is very important that everyone follows the basic rules below. Failure to do this risks you losing the privilege to use technology in school and could result in you facing significant sanctions.

Conditions of Use

- ❖ **Mobile Devices must only be used with the permission of a member of staff.** They should be turned off and kept out of sight at all other times.
- ❖ You must stick to the guidelines/conditions set out in the school's **Student ICT Acceptable Use Policy** (available on Frog):
 - Do not take photos or videos with any device during lessons unless the member of staff has given permission.
 - Do not take photos of people without their permission.
 - Bullying by text or any other method will be treated in the same severe manner as any other form of bullying.
- ❖ **Your device is your responsibility.** The school accepts no responsibility should your device be lost or damaged.
- ❖ Failure to follow these conditions will result in your access to the BYOD network being withdrawn and/or other sanctions.
