



Mind Mapping




Don't over complicate your mind-map. You should have a clear topic in the centre leading to 5 or 6 main points. Each main point could split into some smaller sub-points. Try to keep words to a minimum.

For example, if making a mind-map about photosynthesis, don't write: "A fundamental component in the process of photosynthesis is chlorophyll-which is found in the leaves of green plants"

Instead, write: "Requires chlorophyll"
