### HISTORY

<b>Title:</b> History trip to Berlin
<b>Duration:</b> 4 Days
<b>Departure Date:</b> 29 <sup>th</sup> March 2016
<b>Description:</b> To contextualise GCSE and A level Courses.
<b>Open to:</b> Year 11 and Year 13 history students
<b>Cost:</b> £650

<b>Title:</b> History visit to WW1 Battlefields
<b>Duration:</b> 3 Days
<b>Departure Date:</b> 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2016
<b>Description:</b> To gain an understanding of key sites associated with the Western Front in WW1. To experience the Battle of the Somme 100 years on.
<b>Open to:</b> Year 9
<b>Cost:</b>

### GEOGRAPHY

<b>Title:</b> Geography trip to Sicily
<b>Duration:</b> 5 days
<b>Departure Date:</b> 27 <sup>th</sup> May 2016 (Annual)
<b>Description:</b> A chance to explore a tectonically active area and learn about the Geography and History of Sicily. Includes a trip to Stromboli to witness the volcanic eruptions and an excursion to the summit of Mt Etna – Europe's highest active volcano.
