<p>Someone who is interested in what has happened.</p>	<p>To tell the reader what has happened in an informative and perhaps, entertaining way.</p>	<p>Newspaper Article Summary of events Cartoon Strip Methodology write-up.</p>	<p>Paragraphs are organised over time to be able to show what happened in order.</p> <p>The first paragraph will begin with the earliest event and then the next, etc.</p> <p>Words used precisely to record events accurately.</p> <p>Use of places/dates/times.</p>	<p>Use of the PAST tense.</p> <p>First person or third person.</p> <p>Connectives which help explain what happened over time.</p> <p>Firstly... Secondly... Thirdly... Afterwards... Preceding/Proceeding this... Eventually... Currently...</p>
